Dear Parents, this letter outlines our final plans for our upcoming show at The Radlett Centre in July. All rehearsals will continue to take place during scheduled class times up to and including Friday 12th July. We will then go into our show week timetable where you will be required at set times and days which you will hopefully already have penciled. The show week is to organise and arrange the backstage logistics, conform to our show regulations and to give the students a feel of how the show will run. This is the most important part of the show preparation. Closer to the time, you'll receive a personalised letter with your child's specific schedule. Until then, here's a breakdown of the whole "show week schedule" for your reference. Some dancers will need to bring specific items as well as wear age-appropriate stage makeup and style their hair accordingly, all of which will be detailed in an email closer to the time.

You'll see at the bottom of your email a list of your child's dance name and team (Team 1, Team 2 or Team Seniors), allowing you to identify their time slots and show days below. Particularly if you're a first time show parent, the information can look vast, but I can assure you, the week runs like clockwork!

ALL required rehearsals and show days are <u>mandatory</u>, and <u>all students must participate in their whole</u> <u>schedule</u>. Failure to attend rehearsals would result in the student not being able to be in the final show due to our strict licensing & health and safety regulations. If your child can no longer take part after reading the final schedule, please let me know urgently.

There are over 350 students in the show and over 1000 costumes to supply. I kindly request parents to understand that we are unable to accommodate individual requests.

SHOW DAYS:

DRESS/TECH REHEARSALS:

WHEN:

SENIORS PERFORM ON BOTH DAYS

Thursday 18th July (Team 1 & All seniors Tech/Dress rehearsal)
Friday 19th July (Team 2 & All seniors Tech/Dress rehearsal)

WHERE: The Radlett Centre, Radlett

Action photos will be taken of your child by the photographer and available to buy at the show. Students should be in full hair and make up for the technical & dress rehearsal.

DRESS/TECH REHEARSALS:

Act 1 Students Arrive 4:15pm Start: 4:45pm

Collect Approx. 6:15pm if not in Act 2.

The show is run in order so if your child's dance is early in Act 1 then they will be finished earlier. We will keep them in the changing room until a parent collects them from the sign out area.

(Unless they wish to be in the finale in which case, they will need to stay for the duration of the show)

15 min interval

Act 2 Students Arrive 5:45pm Collect Approx. 7:45pm

Again, the show is run in order so if your child's dance is early in Act 2 then they will be finished earlier.

<u>ALL</u> students will be required for the dress/tech run through. Please be patient with regards to the running time, as this is the <u>ONLY</u> opportunity the lighting and sound team must ensure everything is set up. We cannot foresee any technical difficulties that might occur, and we aim to ensure that the rehearsal will run as smoothly and as quickly as possible.

Only those who have signed up to be a chaperone will be allowed in the dressing rooms, we will require a lot of chaperones so please do help us if you can. Please remember chaperones would need to stay for the duration of either the show or an act.

The theatre's café and local shops will be open for parents to wait if not chaperoning.

Drop off and pick up areas for students will be clearly signposted and chaperones will be around throughout the rehearsal at the theater. Students will not be allowed to leave without a parent unless permission is given.

LEGALLY, STUDENTS MUST HAVE A BREAK BETWEEN SHOWS, THEREFORE, STUDENTS MUST BE COLLECTED AND WILL BE SIGNED OUT OF THEIR DRESSING ROOMS AFTER THE 11AM SHOW. The theatre's café and local shops will be open for food, many parents/groups of students book one of the local restaurants, a few minutes walk from the theatre. Students will not be allowed to leave without a parent unless permission is given on their show form.
