Dance company news:



I have been a member of the Lets Dance family for almost as long as I have had a family of my own. My daughter Sophie joined when she was 5, doing Ballet, Modern & Tap. She continued to dance into her early teens, she is now 32. Matthew came to ballet with Miss Theresa, making his stage debut as a mole at 3 years!

He didn't stick with dance but continued with gymnastics for a number of years.

Over the years I have watched LDA transform from Lets Dance under the wing of Siobhan Chown to Lets

Dance Academy now steered by Becky Sherman.

After a great deal of thought I decided the time had come to consider hanging up my dance shoes. Personal circumstances meant I needed to to concentrate on my family and spend more time with my husband. The gradual staging of my leaving helped me to adjust and also Becky & myself hoped it would support the students. Although I am retiring from LDA it would be impossible for me to stop teaching dance. I am planning to still teach a few Adult Ballet classes with some existing dancers who have been with me since I moved to St Albans.

I cannot thank you enough for all your kind well wishes, gifts, flowers, cards and the generous collection. Your kind words and memories written in cards brought me to tears many times.
